Subject Description for Master in International Economic Relations

1. International Economics Fundamentals

Target:

This subject aims to provide students in international relations with a basic economic understanding of globalization and the functioning of the global economy.

Syllabus:

The course addresses the economic theory, tools, and institutions that underpin international relations, trade, and finance. Students will gain a working knowledge of the basic principles and tools of economics to understand and to analyze major questions and trends in the global economy. Such analytic knowledge is central to a successful career in international relations, and a fundamental literacy in economics is therefore of critical importance in the preparation of future leaders in this field.

2. International Relations Theories

Target:

This subject aims to provide students with information about international relation theories as a basic part of scientific theories.

Syllabus:

Historical study to international relations for the period between 1919 and 1939- game theory and system theory- studying of macro theories in international relations (power theory and war theory)- studying for recent issues in international relations (globalization)- studying of Islamic theory in international relations.

3. International Economics Relations and Development

Target:

This subject aims to provide the student with many concepts of international economic relations.

Syllabus:

The distinct nature of international trade and the need to distinguish it from domestic trade - trade policy and its doctrines - features of the contemporary economic system - balance of payments - multinational companies, international organizations of an economic nature - shock economy - economy of resistance

4. International Law and Enterprises

Target:

This subject aims to aware students with information about international law and international organizations and how to solve international conflicts.

Syllabus:

Introduction to international law and its two basic stages, the classical stage and the modern stage- studying international organizations- main resources of international law and focusing on the role of international agreements in developing international law that is related to human rights- international conflicts.





5. Policy Science

Target:

This subject aims to provide student with information about policy and its relations with other sciences that increase student's ability to understand international political changes.

Syllabus:

Introduction to policy science- its relations with other sciences- the country and the government concepts- freedom and democracy- conditions that are related to political analyzing.

6. Arab States Economic and Political geography

Target:

This subject aims to provide student with information about Arab States economies and its international importance and impacts.

Syllabus

Economic geography of Arab states- political geography of Arab states.

7. Research Project

Target:

This subject aims to make students aware of the ways and methods of scientific research ,and how to build scientific hypotheses, and collect the required data, and how to write reports and scientific research.

Syllabus:

Preliminary concepts for scientific research - the nature of scientific research - Research Methodology - Recent trends in scientific research curriculum - planning and organization of scientific research - the use of statistical methods in scientific research - Practical Applications.
